

Dallas Lake Lodge

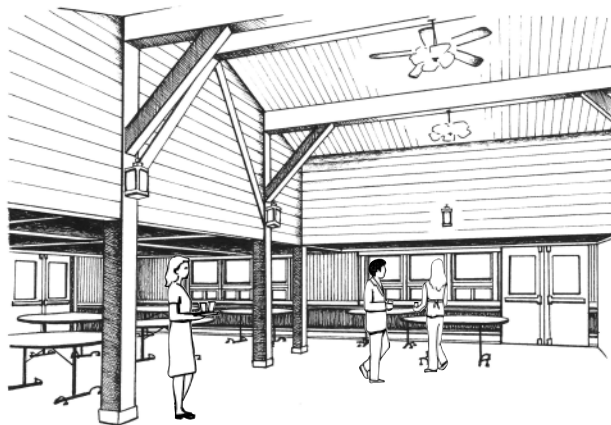
0505W 700S Dallas Lake Park features 96 acres on the south shore of Dallas Lake, a beach staffed by lifeguards in the summer, a playground area, and a wetland natural area with observation deck. The lodge is our largest rental facility, seating up to 112 inside and 24 outside on a patio. It is air conditioned with a kitchen and modern restrooms.

Park Shelter Rules & Policies

- Renter must be present at rental.
- **Alcoholic beverages are prohibited.**
- Damaging signs, shelters, and structures is prohibited.
- It is unlawful to litter or dump trash in the park. Trash must be placed in receptacles.
- Tents, canopies, awnings, etc. are not allowed in shelter/picnic areas except in **approved** designated areas.
- No amplified sound without written permission of Park Director. The volume of music should not disturb other park patrons or renters. 75 decibels or below.
- No live animal exhibits - no petting zoo or pony rides.
- Possession of firearms and weapons is prohibited except bows on designated archery ranges.
- Smoking is not allowed in any park building. Smoking materials are not to be left on ground.
- Defacement, destruction, removal or disturbance of property, equipment, wildlife, flora or natural features is prohibited. Collecting nuts, berries, and mushrooms is allowed.
- All facility renters must be out of the park by posted park closing time. **Park hours are 8 a.m. - sunset.**
- Pets must be restrained on a six (6) foot leash. No pets are allowed in buildings, pavilions or on beach. Service dogs are allowed. Owners must clean up after their pets.
- Swimming is permitted in designated areas and at posted times only.
- Fishing is allowed. Hunting is prohibited. (All state laws apply)
- Disorderly conduct is prohibited, as well as other activities which are deemed dangerous or improper.
- Maximum speed is 15 mph or as posted. Vehicles may be operated only on roadways.
- Fires are restricted to proper containers, in limited areas. No ground fires are permitted. Charcoal fires only.
- A damage and extraordinary clean-up security deposit of \$100 will be required for all enclosed buildings.
- **Horses must be tied to hitching posts.** Horses tied to trees or shrubs are a violation of County Ordinance 2001-7-16.
- No camping.

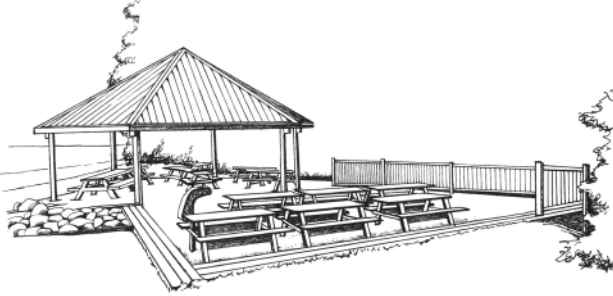
Delt Church Park Pavilions

6455S 200W Delt Church Park borders the Little Elkhart River. Amenities include the Megatower Playground, disc golf course, large grass playing field, and wooded hiking trails. All Park pavilions have access to electricity, water supply, and a grill.

South River Pavilion

Seats approximately 96. Deck overlooks the Little Elkhart River. Close to playground.



East River Pavilion

Seats 72.
Restrooms nearby, Located next to the Little Elkhart River.



Logan/Field Pavilion

Seats approximately 80.
Adjacent to the grass playing field and frog pond.

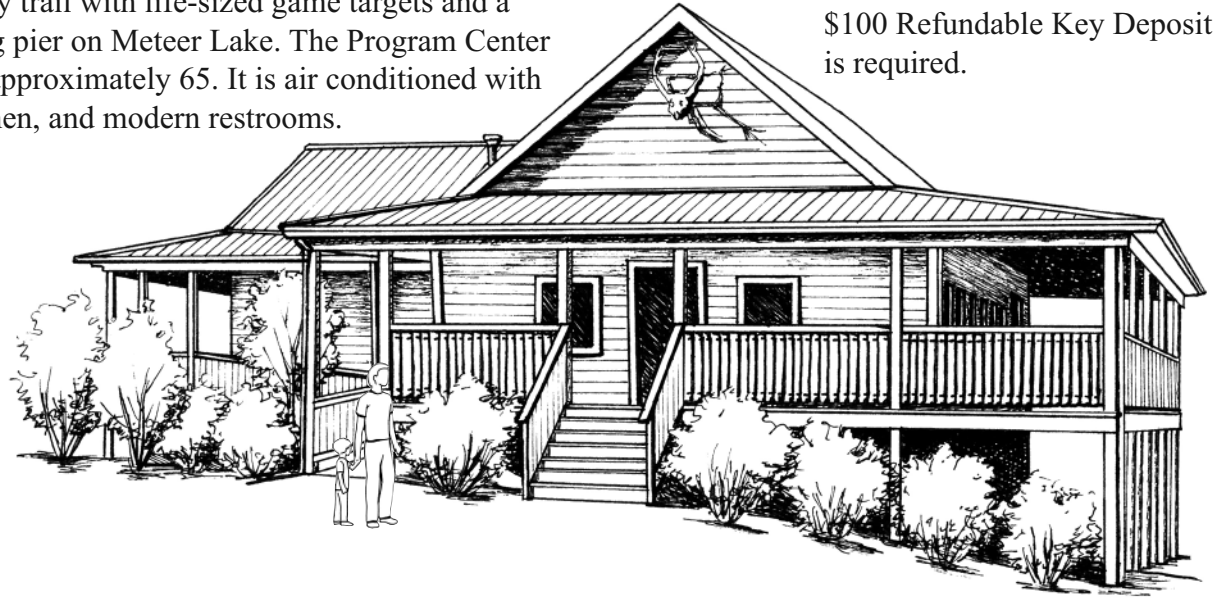


Pine Knob Program Center

2825E SR120 Pine Knob Park includes a 3-D archery trail with life-sized game targets and a fishing pier on Meter Lake. The Program Center seats approximately 65. It is air conditioned with a kitchen, and modern restrooms.

Cost: \$150 per day

\$100 Refundable Key Deposit is required.



David Rogers Memorial Park

2355W 550S Rogers Village is authentic pioneer log cabins and an 1826 log barn. A picturesque location for an outdoor event in a rustic setting. Electricity and water supply are available. Special arrangements can be made for weddings or other large ceremonies requiring use of cabins. Call the Park office for more information.

Maple Wood Nature Center

4550E 100S LaGrange County Nature Preserve is a mixed forest of beech, maple, oak, and hickory with multiple hiking trails. Maple Wood Nature Center is a timber frame structure with beautiful view of this northern hardwood forest.

Maple Wood Nature Center is available for group meetings and gatherings. Rentals are available during posted open hours. EEC seats approximately 64 at tables. It is air conditioned with a kitchen and restrooms.
